12-24-48 RULE

To uphold financial discipline:

- 12 Hours – Bills and proofs must be submitted within 12 hours of any financial transaction else default showcause
- 24 hours – Delay in submission leads to default suspension from current designation for 24 hours
- 48 hours – Continued delay results in default termination from designation in 48 hours.






A structured framework for the organisation

xi) 12-Hour Finance Policy: A volunteer who fails to submit bills/transaction proofs within 12 hours of the payment is liable to immediate suspension/notice/rective without the requirement of any physical notice/approval. Further, if he/she still fails to submit the required bills/transaction proofs within 12 hours of the payment is liable to immediate suspension, effective without the requirement of any physical notice/approval. If he/she still fails to submit the required bills/transaction



13. Working Protocol

A. Review Protocol:

1. The immediate leaders in Street Cause should review the members' work effectively and give necessary instructions.
2. Monthly performance review for the CEO's Office, City Executive Board and the Divisional Executive.



C. Self-Sustainability

- i) Street Cause ensures that the targeted location is made self-sustainable at the end of the project. Any project taken up by any respective Street Cause Division can be divided amongst members into multiple tasks. Dividing up the work enables



individuals for knowledge transfer. SC libraries enable members of the organization to access all the data of the previous years, which could be used for referencing. Any questions arise in the future. The SC offices can be termed as the 'nerve center' of Street Cause, where the way of working is to carefully document every detail, to



Street Cause Zero Tolerance Policy

As an organisation, Street Cause gives financial transparency, proper accountability and compliant behaviour the utmost priority. There will be zero tolerance for any person in the organisation who is not following any of the above. This is applicable for



5. Alumni Status:

- A. Once a SC member completes their tenure with SC successfully, meeting the specified eligibility criteria, they are considered as SC Alumni.
- B. In some unique cases, Alumni status is subject to revocation on grounds of indiscipline, non-performance and financial misuse of SC funds.



- ii) The task report shall be uploaded in line with the finance documents and bills within a timeframe of 24 hours. The bills uploaded shall be by task reports.
- iii) The task reports shall follow the format prescribed by SC (refer to clause 2 in SC Documentation Policy for the prescribed format).



4. Establishment of Street Cause Divisions:

- A. It is strongly advised by Street Cause to have permission of the concerned government to start a Street Cause Division, which is never mandatory.
- B. All the SC divisions that are going to be set up from the year 2022, have to be mandatorily approved by the concerned government first.

STREET CAUSE 2024: A YEAR OF SERVICE, A VISION FOR TOMORROW

Street Cause held its Annual General Meeting on August 31st, 2024 at IARE. This meeting took place in the A/V Room from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM, and it brought together members and volunteers to reflect on the past year's initiatives and set the course for the future. The meeting provided a comprehensive review of the organization's impact and growth. It included a summary of completed projects and fundraising campaigns, highlighting efforts that benefited villages, old-age homes, orphans, and schools, with volunteers contributing service. They presented an annual financial report highlighting revenue, expenditures and remaining funds earmarked for upcoming initiatives. As a token of appreciation, certifications and citations were awarded to coordinators and volunteers, with special recognition given to those who played a key role in the RFC event. Symbolizing a leadership transition and the continued evolution of Street Cause, the next executive board was announced. Another key point that was discussed was the organization's expansion plan of branching into new cities, launching new projects, fostering leadership and increasing awareness through campaigns.
