12-24-48 RULE

To uphold financial discipline:

- 12 Hours – Bills and proofs must be submitted within 12 hours of any financial transaction else default showcase
- 24 hours – Delay in submission leads to default suspension from current designation for 24 hours
- 48 hours – Continued delay results in default termination from designation in 48 hours.

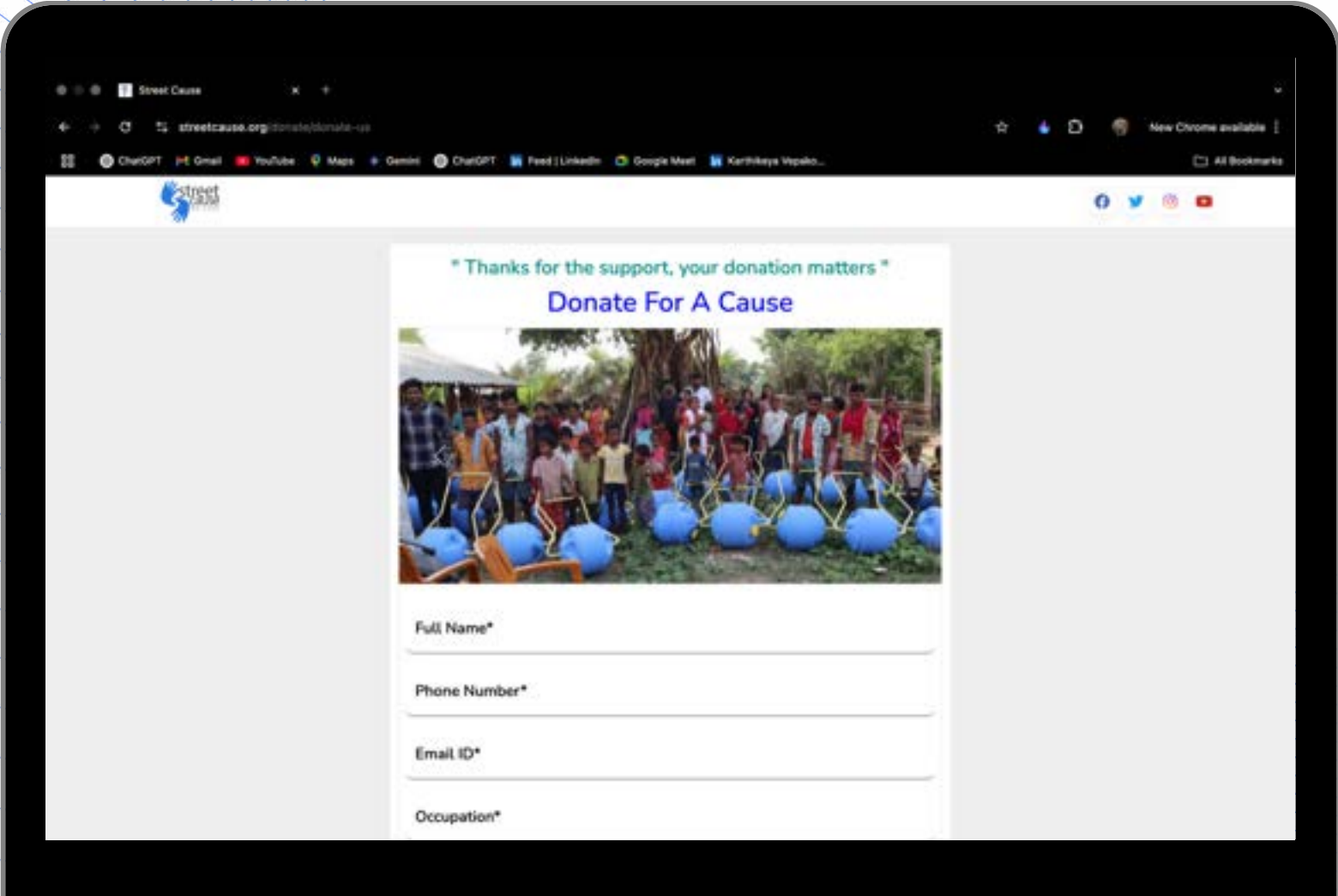

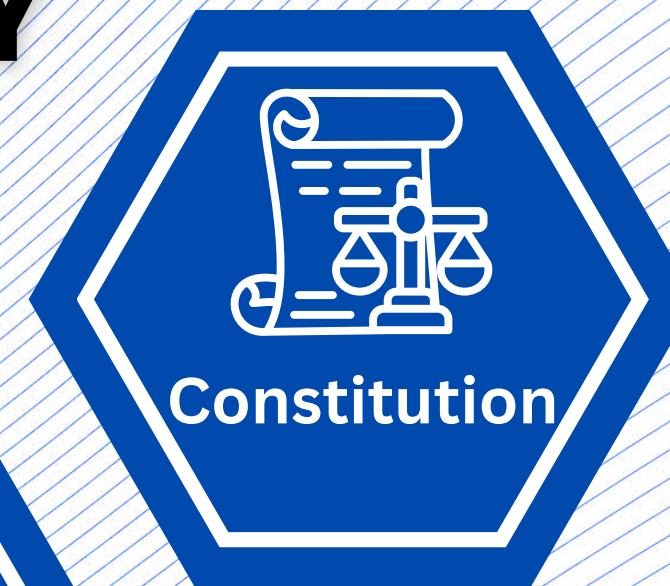

xi) 12-Hour Finance Policy: A volunteer who fails to submit bills/transaction proof within 12 hours of the payment is liable to immediate show cause notice without the requirement of any physical notice/approval. Further, if he/she still fails to submit the required bills/transaction proof within 24 hours of the payment is liable to immediate suspension, effective without the requirement of any physical notice/approval. If he/she still fails to submit the required bills/transaction

A. Review Protocol:
